

PRIZE STRUCTURE

- \$30 minimum bet per race; \$100 maximum bet.
- Win, Place, Show wagers ONLY [or combination WPS].
- One horse per race.
- Contestants keep all pari-mutuel winnings.

CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

- \$1,000 entry fee is non-refundable and required with entry form. An additional \$300 "betting card" purchase is required. Players may pay the non-refundable entry fee one of two ways: (1) cash or (2) money order/cashier's check made payable to Meadowlands Racetrack. Personal checks are not accepted.
- Entrants keep all pari-mutuel winnings.
- Entrants cannot add additional cash to tournament bankroll; doing so results in automatic disqualification.
- Buy-in entries accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. There is no limit to the number of total entrants.
- Three entries allowed per person person. Players that have qualified for more than three seats must assign their fourth seat to a participant of their choice.
- Entrants must bet exactly 10 races: two (2) designated mandatory races (one each from Buffalo & Meadowlands); plus, player's choice of eight (8) Meadowlands live races. Mandatory races will be posted by 10 pm on Thursday, April 11.
- \$30 minimum bet per race, \$100 maximum.
- Win, Place, Show wagers only [or any combination W/P/S].
- One horse per race.
- Using your betting card to wager in any other pools or on any other simulcast signals results in automatic disqualification.
- Withdrawing money before the last race is official or without Tournament Director approval results in automatic disqualification.
- Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the Player.
- All tournament wagers must be made on self-service terminals (SST's) using your betting card and pin number.
- In case of cancellation of a contest race or track due to inclement weather or other circumstances beyond our control, the Meadowlands reserves the right to end the contest or designate alternate contest race(s) or track(s).
- Inclement Weather Plan: If the Meadowlands cancels the April 13, 2019 card, in part or in its entirety, players must complete their required wagers using races from Woodbine Mohawk Park. If the mandatory race from Buffalo is canceled, players must choose additional Meadowlands race to complete their mandatory wagers.
- No cancellations on any wagers for any reason after post time. In the event of a late scratch, contestants must follow NJRC cancellation procedures.
- If a selection in a mandatory race is scratched, players must select another horse in the race to complete their wager. Failure to complete a wager in a mandatory race results in automatic disqualification.
- All official track rulings apply to horses selected for tournament play.
- Meadowlands and Sportech Inc. are not responsible for "shut-outs," incomplete transactions or for the mechanical failure of any tote machine used for contest wagering. No exceptions under any circumstances. All wagers should be placed early to avoid being shut out.
- The Players Club Desk is the home base of the contest; all announcements will be posted there.
- Meadowlands is not responsible for lost or mutilated betting cards.
- All questions or problems should immediately be reported to Tournament Director Rachel Ryan at the Players Club Desk.
- The decisions of the judges and the NMRLLC in all matters or disputes relating to this handicapping challenge are final.

GENERAL RULES

- Must be 18 years of age or older by April 13, 2019 and have a valid ID to register and participate in the WHHC presented by DerbyWars.com.
- Winners are responsible for all applicable state and federal taxes and required IRS forms.

- Employees of NMR, Sportech Inc., & NJRC and their family members are not eligible.
- Licensed horse owners and trainers are eligible to participate, but are required to identify themselves in writing by completing and submitting the enclosed licensing form to tournament officials and identify any vested interest(s) they have in any tournament race(s) by completing and submitting the provided horsemen's declaration form. All horse owners and trainers are ineligible to wager, for tournament purposes, on any race in which they have a horse(s) competing, and/or any other vested interest.
- Failure to notify tournament officials of any vested interest in race(s) eligible for wagering in this tournament, or wagering on any race where said entrant has an interest, will result in automatic disqualification with no entry fee refund.
- The NMRLLC reserves the right to make changes to the contest rules and format as necessary.
