

PADDOCK ENTRY AND PROCEDURE PROTOCOL

- Only NJRC licensed personnel will be granted access to stable area/paddock
- Upon arrival to paddock gate please present completed Covid19 questionnaire
- Any personnel with symptoms of Covid19 via the questionnaire will be denied entry
- Temperature will be taken on all personnel with no-touch thermometer
- Individuals with a temperature over 100.4f will be denied entry
- Upon entry face coverings must be worn at all times. Failure to comply will result in expulsion
- Gloves should be worn as much as possible
- Social distance of 6 feet required
- There are to be no gatherings of persons at any time
- Personnel used to race horses must be kept to a minimum
- No owners, truck drivers/shippers or any other non-essential persons shall be admitted
- Stalls will be assigned. It is the obligation of the connections to secure horses in assigned stalls
- Horses are to remain in assigned stalls at all times except to go to track or empty out stall
- LASIX will be given as directed by the NJRC or its representative.
- Grooms are to stay with their horses at all times exception to use restroom
- Trainers are to remain in the area of their horse(s) at all times other than to go onto the track
- Drivers will remain outside the paddock isolated in their personal vehicle
- Contact with drivers must be via cell phone
- Drivers will pick mounts up as the horses emerge from paddock on the way to the track
- Drivers will return to Winners Circle alone with horse for a picture
- There will be no transporting of handlers to the Winners Circle they must remain in the paddock
- Drivers return to isolation upon return to paddock
- Trainers who drive are permitted to participate in paddock preparation only for their horses
- Handlers of all horses being tested must explicitly follow the instructions of NJRC personnel
- Horses are to be removed from the paddock and grounds as quickly as possible
